Cost	Free	Free	You may have to pay your primary care physician (PCP) office visit copay. The blood test will be billed to your medical plan. Your doctor should screen for cholesterol, including HDL, glucose and A1C. All testing must be completed or the form will be rejected as incomplete. If you are enrolled in prescription drug or supplemental benefits only, you may incur costs under your non-PEBTF medical plan. Bronze Plan members will have the cost of the office visit and blood test applied to their deductible. Your preventive benefits allow for one cholesterol test, fasting glucose test and routine A1C every calendar year. If you had one of these tests in 2025, your medical plan will not pay for another blood test. You should go to a Quest Diagnostics PSC or attend an onsite event because that testing is free of charge.
Advantages	Convenient Fast (takes 15 minutes) No travel time required if an event is held in your building. Subject to operational needs, employees will be given time off to attend an onsite event.	Convenient – locations throughout the state (Saturday hours are offered at most locations) Subject to operational needs, employees will be given time off to visit a Patient Service Center.	Schedule directly with your doctor. Testing must be done between January 1, 2025 and December 31, 2025, so if you recently had a blood test, your doctor may submit those results. Employees must take leave to visit the doctor.
How to Prepare for Your Screening	It is not necessary that you fast. However, your results will be more accurate if you do not have any food or drink except water for 9 to 12 hours prior to your blood draw. Remember to drink plenty of water and take all medications as prescribed by your doctor.		
How Do I Make an Appointment	Follow the registration instructions on the PEBTF website on or after July 1. You should register in advance to guarantee an appointment. Walk-ins will not be accepted this year nor will same day requests to change appointments	Follow the registration instructions on the PEBTF website on or after July 1. You will then be able to choose an appointment date and time. You are strongly encouraged to make an appointment and not schedule as a walk-in, which will cut down on wait time. Do not wait until the deadline because Patient Service Centers may be closed on December 31 for the holiday.	Complete the online registration to print a Physician Results Form. It will populate with your demographic information. Schedule an appointment with your doctor well in advance of December 31, 2025. Provide the Physician Results Form to your doctor. Your doctor must complete the Physician Results Form in its entirety. You must upload or fax the form to Quest Diagnostics by the deadline.
